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Program Notes

There have been many occasions when I have been awestruck by things in this world that made me feel small and insignificant. *Things that are bigger than us* was inspired by one such thing – the night hum. I find myself drawn to the traditional romanticism of the night, captivated by its mysticism and poetic qualities. While star-gazing one night, I became aware of a drone-like noise that was low, somewhat machine-like. This distant but ever-present noise seemed to

me like a reminder that even while we sleep, the world does not stop.

In this piece, I try to convey the feeling of vastness that I experience looking up at the night sky. Long drone-like lines obscure a melody trying to manifest itself from a seemingly distant place. The drones create a desolate environment. The piece builds to a romantic outburst before the night takes over again.

Composer Biography

Michael Maevskiy (b. 1997) is a Canadian composer based in Kingston. His music explores conceptual and philosophical ideas, often expressed through visceral gesture and ephemeral apparitions of sound. His style favours rich harmonies and melodic lines transfigured through a contemporary perspective, inspired by his heritage of romantic and contemporary Russian composers.

Michael has written for voice, chamber ensembles, choir, opera, and orchestra. His music has been performed across Canada and Italy, having worked with musicians and ensembles including Véronique Lacroix, Audréanne Filion, Joella Pinto, Quatuor Bozzini, Duo Concertante, and Unassisted Fold. His music has also been performed at the highSCORE festival, Tuckamore Chamber Music festival,

Bozzini Lab, Scarborough Symphony Orchestra's New Generation Composer workshop, the Orford New Music Workshop, the inaugural Piano Lunaire Composers' Symposium, and the 2023 Array Young Composer's Workshop. He has scored for film in collaboration with animators from Sheridan College.

Michael's work has been supported by the Canada Council for the Arts, as well as receiving multiple SOCAN Foundation Young Composers Awards. Furthermore, he was selected as part of the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra's Composer Fellowship Program (2023/2024) and his works can be found in the ACNMP's Contemporary Showcase Syllabi for violin and piano.
